ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL SERVICE FEE ORDINANCE, 78-002 EXEMPTING CERTAIN PROPERTIES FROM THE MUNICIPAL SERVICE FEE AND PROVIDING FOR FURTHER PENALTIES AND CHARGES FOR LATE PAYMENT.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough of Yoe Council, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION I

Section 8 of the Municipal Ordinance 78-002 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Charges imposed by this Ordinance, 78-002 as amended shall be a lien on the unit where it is located, any such charges which are not paid within thirty (30) days after each quarterly billing date, at the discretion of the Borough, shall be filed as a lien against the aforesaid property which lien shall be filed in the Office of the Prothonotary of York County, Pennsylvania, and shall be collected in the manner provided by law for the filing and collection of municipal claims. A late fee of fifteen (\$15.00) dollars is hereby imposed in addition to any court costs on all accounts where a municipal claim is filed. A Charge is further imposed in all instances where a Writ of Scira Facias is filed equal to the lesser of the Borough's attorney's fees or twenty (20) percent of the face amount of the liens, penalties, and late charges."

SECTION II

Section 9 of the Municipal Ordinance 78-002 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"No property owner shall be charged a Municipal Service fee for any business premises owned by him which is located inside his principal residence, on the same premises as his principal

residence, on any tract of land abutting his principal residence or which is contiguous with his principal residence and other land owned by him provided that business is wholly owned by the property owner or members of his household. A "business premises" within the meaning of this section shall be any property other than a residential dwelling unit."

SECTION III

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
