

ORDINANCE.

Ordinance of right to lay Gas Mains etc.
An ordinance giving the consent of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pennsylvania, to Interborough Gas and Fuel Company, its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain a system for supplying gas in the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pennsylvania.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of Yoe, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same.

SECTION 1. That permission is hereby granted to Interborough Gas and Fuel Company (hereafter referred to as the Company, which term shall include its successors and assigns) to construct, operate and maintain a complete gas system, including gas mains and pipes under the streets and highways of said Borough, under and subject however to the terms and conditions hereinafter named.

SECTION 2. The Company shall replace all materials excavated and re-lay all bricks or other pavement removed so that the same shall be in the same good mechanical or substantial condition as before they were disturbed and the aforesaid Company shall place their mains and pipes, so as to be of the least obstruction to public travel, subject to approval of the Highway Committee.

SECTION 3. The said Company shall indemnify and save harmless the said Borough of and from any and all claims or suits for damage which may arise by reason of the presence, location, construction or operation of said Gas Plant and pipes, whether the said damage be done to the said Borough, or to any person or persons, or the property of such person or persons.

SECTION 4. That the said Company shall within sixty days after the approval of this Ordinance, signify in proper writing filed with the Clerk of Council aforesaid, its acceptance of this franchise and all the regulations, conditions, and reconstruction herein contained.

SECTION 5. That the said Company shall pay to the Borough Council aforesaid, all the costs of the enactment of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances now in existence inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
