

ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE INDEBTEDNESS  
OF YOE BOROUGH FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING  
FOR THE PAVING OF CERTAIN STREETS OF THE  
BOROUGH.

Signifying and expressing the desire of the corporate authorities of the Borough of Yoe, County of York and State of Pennsylvania, to increase the indebtedness of said Borough by the amount of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) for the purpose of paying for the paving of certain streets of said Borough, constructing culverts and inlets, as well as all other matters and things necessary in and about the works of such paying, providing for the holding of an election therefore and authorizing and directing the corporate authorities to make the necessary announcements of said election and do all other acts and things incidents thereto.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Borough of Yoe and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same: That the corporate authorities of the Borough of Yoe hereby signify and express their desire to increase the bonded indebtedness of the Borough of Yoe by the amount of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) for the purpose of paying for the paving of certain streets of said Borough, constructing culverts and inlets, as well as all other matters and things necessary in and about the work of such paving.

SECTION 2. That a public election be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to be held at the usual hours and places on the 7th day of November, A. D. 1939, for the purpose of obtaining the assent of the electors of the said Borough for the increase of the bonded indebtedness of the Borough by the amount and for the purposes aforesaid and the corporate authorities are hereby authorized and directed to make the necessary announcements of said election through their Chief Burgess, and do all other acts and things incident thereto.
