Ordinance 99-05

Mr. Snyder asked for public comment and there was none. Ordinance 99-05 which fixes the salary of mayor, president, vice president and members of council. Changes to be the salary of the mayor shall be \$100.00 per month, salary of the President of council shall be \$100.00 per month, salary of Vice president of council shall be \$75.00 per month and salary of borough council shall be \$60.00 per month. A motion was made by Mr. Diehl to adopt ordinance 99-05. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Smith. All in favor.

Resolution 99-8

This resolution sets the compensation fee for the tax collector. The tax collector shall receive 5% of all real estate taxes received. The tax collector shall receive \$1.40 per bill for flat taxes. A motion was made by Mr. Diehl to adopt resolution 99-8. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Smith. All in favor.

Resolution 99-9

This resolution addresses the fire company's concern and the problems concerning the financial statements. There is a change from the original sent to council. Item 3 states borough council may at its discretion give sums it deems appropriate for the first six months of the year in good faith without a review of the previous year's financial statement before any monies are expended for the third and fourth quarter of any applicable year. A financial statement shall be provided. Mr. Snyder said this recognizes that we can give in good cause to make donations to fire companies, ambulance clubs, and a little. If it is a gift over \$500.00 we are requesting a financial statement for the preceding year. A motion was made by Mr. Diehl to adopt resolution 99-9. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Smith. All in favor.

Solicitor's Report

Mr. Solymos said in regards to the situation at 34-36 W. Broad St. with bee infestation, the best approach was for Mr. Smith to talk to the individual who was in the home to get insight into how bad the condition was. Mr. Smith found the place was messy and reeked of cigar smoke. Mr. Solymos said he felt this was not an appropriate time to take action. Mr. Smith will monitor situation and the bee situation is resolved.

Mr. Solymos said the truck was sold.

Mr. Solymos reviewed the police contract for 2000. The legal fee is fine. There is a 6% increase in cost. Mr. Solymos said this contract is for council to review and to take note there is a merger with Windsor Township to take place.
