

**RESOLUTION NO.: 2000 - 11**

**WHEREAS**, as part of its charge to protect the general health, safety, and welfare of the Citizens of Yoe Borough, Borough Council has provided for snow removal within the Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of the Borough of Yoe has the authority to declare a snow emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, during times of snow emergency, it is the desire of Borough Council to restrict parking on certain Borough Streets.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF YOE**, as follows:

1. Upon the Mayor declaring a snow emergency, the following streets will be designated as no parking:

- A) Elm Street on the west side,
- B) Broad Street on the south side,
- C) Church Street - on both sides,
- D) Walnut Street on the south side,
- E) Main Street on the east side, and
- F) North Maple Street on the west side.

2. Pursuant to the adoption of this Resolution, Borough Council, its agents and/or assigns, are hereby authorized to post appropriate signage designating snow emergency routes and no parking areas during snow emergencies.


