

## **RESOLUTION NO.: 2003 - 1**

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of Yoe Borough Council to promote civic responsibility and interest in the youth of the Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, the Pennsylvania Association of Boroughs has proposed that Municipalities embark upon a Junior Council Persons Program; and

**WHEREAS**, Borough Council believes that embarking on such a program will be of benefit to the citizens, as well as the youth of Yoe Borough.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AND IT IS HEREBY**

**RESOLVED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF YOE**, as follows:

1. Borough Council is hereby authorized to appoint a youth of Yoe Borough under the age of eighteen (18) and a junior in high school, to a position of Junior Council Member to sit and take part in Borough Council Meetings during the normal school year, and at other times when the Junior Council Persons schedule allows.

2. That such appointment shall be for one (1) year.

3. That such Council Person shall attend all Council Meetings and be able to take part in all discussions involving Borough business.

4. That the Junior Council Person however, will not be authorized to vote on Borough matters, nor will the Junior Council Person be authorized to attend or take part in Executive Sessions of the Borough.


