**A RESOLUTION NAMING A BOROUGH REPRESENTATIVE TO BE APPOINTED AS A POINT OF CONTACT AND ACT AS AGENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH AND PEMA. IN REGARD TO SECURING REIMBURSEMENT ASSOCIATED TO THE EMERGENCY DECLARATION OF HURRICANE IDA**

*WHEREAS*, The State of Pennsylvania declared a disaster in response to the remnants of Hurricane Ida for the incident period of Aug 31, 2021 - Sep 5, 2021 under 4618-DR-PA, which impacted parts of the state.

*WHEREAS*, the County of York was designated as one of the impacted counties as being effected and municipalities within that county are eligible to apply for assistance in helping to defray the costs due to the impact of Hurricane Ida.

*WHEREAS*, the Borough of Yoe is located in York County and did sustain damage directly associated with the hurricane during the incident period.

*WHEREAS*, pursuant to the regulations, each municipality which sustained damage and makes application for assistance, must appoint a person of contact on behalf of the municipality, to act as an agent for the municipality and be able to sign all documents associated with the application process to obtain assistance.

*NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED*, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pennsylvania, that Mayor John Sanford is appointed as an agent to represent the Borough in this matter and sign all appropriate documents and to act as an agent for the Borough in this matter.

*SO BE IT RESOLVED*, this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November 2021 by the Borough Council of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pennsylvania.
