

YOE BOROUGH RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION FIXING THE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE YEAR 2022 FOR GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES

WHEREAS, The State of Pennsylvania passed P.L.351 act 51 of 2019 on July 2nd 2019 and which became effective August 31,2019, which amends Title 8 of the Pennsylvania Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Yoe, in accordance with provisions of the Pennsylvania Borough Code as amended by P.L.351 Act 51 of 2019, which amends Sections 1302 (a)to read as follows “The council of the borough shall have power by resolution for taxes levied at the same rate as or at a rate lower than the previous fiscal year, and by ordinance if the tax rate increases from the previous fiscal year.”; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Yoe, in accordance with the provisions of the Pennsylvania Borough Code, Title 8. Act 37 of 2014, Chapter 13 section 1302 (a) (6) & (9) and section 1302.1(a) may enact certain taxes and special levy taxes and establish millage rates therefore; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Borough Code, such taxes and millage rates must be adopted by Ordinance or Resolution by the municipality each year; and

WHEREAS, the tax levy rates being adopted this year are at the same rate as last Year, and may therefore be adopted by Resolution under section 1302 (a) ; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Yoe, York County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION I

1. The millage rate for general revenue purposes for real estate tax for the year 2021 is hereby fixed at 3.955 mills.
2. The millage rate for annual fire tax for fire protection for the year 2022 is hereby fixed at .452 mills.
3. The millage rate for annual emergency services for the year 2022 is hereby fixed at .500 mills

SECTION II


1. The funds generated from the annual fire protection tax and the annual emergency services tax, as outlined in Section I, shall be considered "Special Levy Taxes". Which funds shall be set aside in separate fund accounts and are to be used for fire protection and emergency services including police protection.

SECTION III

1. The effective date of this Resolution shall be January 1, 2022.
