AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE I (IN GENERAL), SECTION 2-3, WARD BOUNDARIES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES (ORDINANCE NO. 2002-24) OF THE CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Troy, Illinois, does hereby determine that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Troy, Illinois, to maintain ward boundaries in as equal of a population as possible; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, has reviewed and analyzed the population of the City of Troy, Illinois, and believes that it is necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Troy, Illinois, to revise the ward boundaries to reflect the current population of the City of Troy, Illinois, and to maintain geographically compact and contiguous boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, has also reviewed and analyzed the current text of Chapter 2, Article I (In General), Section 2-3, Ward Boundaries, of the Code of Ordinances (Ordinance No. 2002-24) and determined accordingly that several provisions contained therein require certain additions, modifications and/or updating to reflect the current population of the City of Troy, Illinois, and to maintain geographically compact and contiguous boundaries;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The recitals set forth above are true and correct and hereby incorporated herein.

Section 2: Chapter 2, Article I (In General), Section 2-3, Ward Boundaries, of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Troy, Illinois, is hereby amended in its entirety as set forth herein:

“The boundaries of the wards of the City shall be as follows:

Ward 1 – Starting at the North East corner of Center Street and Collinsville Road going East on Center Street to Washington Street, then South to Prospect Street, then East to South Main Street, then South and including all other property located to the West of South Main Street to Route 40, then East along Route 40, then South Easterly along the North Easterly property line of Hampton Glen Subdivision, then South along the North/South property line of said subdivision to Country Lane, then west on the north side of Country Lane and the South property line of

Meadowbrooke Subdivision to the North/South property line of Spring Valley Subdivision, then South to the East/West property line of Charleston Subdivision, then West to Spring Valley Road, then North on Spring Valley Road to the North boundary line of Spring Valley Subdivision, then East along said subdivision boundary line to the North/South line of said subdivision, then North and West along the city corporate line to Route 40, then East along the city corporate line to Sherburne Avenue, then going northerly along the city corporate line to Collinsville Road. Then following Collinsville Road North East to Center Street at the point of beginning.

Ward 2 – Starting at the South East corner of Market Street and S. Main Street going East to Hickory Street, then North on West side of Staunton Road to the intersection of Kimberlin Street, then Westerly following the city corporate line to the Northerly city corporate line, then North to the Pin Oak Township line, then West to the West boundary of the Third Addition to Northwoods at Park Forest, then South Easterly to the intersection of the Third Addition to Northwoods at Park Forest and Park Forest #12, then west along the South boundary of Northwoods at Park Forest, then South West along the East side of Hummingbird Court to the South side of Bluebird Lane, then West to Reid Avenue, then West to Riggins Road, then South to the intersection of Collinsville Road and Spring Valley Road, then North Easterly on Collinsville Road to Market Street, then East to the point of beginning.

Ward 3 – All property to the East of Wards 1 and 2 and North of Route 40.

Ward 4 – All property to the West of Ward 1 and 2 and North of Ward 2.

Section 3: That all other provisions of Chapter 2, Article I (In General), of the Code of Ordinances shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect except as specifically amended by this Ordinance.

Section 4: If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, signing and publication as required by law.
