ORDINANCE NO. 2012- 10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, CHAPTER 32, SECTION 125 - DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS - OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, has reviewed the provisions of the current text of Title III, Chapter 32, Section 125 of the Code of Ordinances and determined that it requires certain additions and amendments to conform with current operational practices; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it will be beneficial and in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the City of Troy, Illinois, to amend the Code of Ordinances accordingly.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

Section 2. Section 32.125 – Director of Public Works - of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Troy, Illinois, is hereby amended in its entirety as set forth herein:

TITLE III. Administration

Chapter 32 – OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES AND OTHER WORKERS

Section 35.125 – DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS

There is hereby created the position of Director of Public Works, an executive position of the city. The Director of Public Works shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the City Council annually at or near the beginning of the fiscal year. The Director of Public Works shall be responsible for the supervision and management of the Water and Sewer Department, the Street Department, all public works projects and such other duties presented by

the Mayor and the City Council. The Director of Public Works shall possess and maintain the qualifications and credentials required by law and the city. The Director of Public Works shall be responsible for planning, organizing, directing, managing, supervising and coordinating the activities of the Public Works Department consisting of the Water and Sewer Department and the Street Department. The Director of Public Works shall report to the City Administrator. The Director of Public Works shall attend all City Council meetings and other meetings as requested by the Mayor or the City Administrator or as necessary to perform the duties and responsibilities of the position. Any references to Street Superintendent, Water & Sewer Superintendent, Superintendent of Public Works and Utility Superintendent in the Code of Ordinances shall hereinafter be interpreted to refer to the Director of Public Works or his or her designee.

Section 3: If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, signing and publication as required by law.
