To whom it may concern:

For your contact information, Tammy Mitchell has resigned as City Clerk; Jamie Myers has taken her place.

Enclosed are several ordinances for codification. Ordinance 2012-11 has some special instructions. I spoke with Paul Jones of American Legal and he suggested that I ask for some direction on how to codify this ordinance that repeals *Section 32.126 Street Superintendent*.

Paul said American Legal can codify this ordinance a couple of different ways: inserting an editor's note in *Section 32.125 Director of Public Works* stating that all references to Street Superintendent now refer to the Director of Public Works, or doing a "global substitution" changing any references of Street Superintendent to the Director of Public Works.

A brief search of our code shows approximately 34 hits of "Superintendent." Two of those refer to the Police Department but the others can all be changed to "Director of Public Works."

I am asking for a quote as to how much it would cost to substitute Director of Public Work at any reference to Street Superintendent, Water and Sewer Superintendent, and Superintendent of Public Works. This quote, or any suggestions on how to remove any references to "Street Superintendent" from our code, can be emailed to me at ltaake@troyil.us.

ORDINANCE NO. 2012- 11

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING TITLE III, CHAPTER 32, SECTION 126
(ORDINANCE NO. 1995-16) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY
OF TROY, ILLINOIS, AND THE POSITION OF STREET SUPERINTENDENT**

WHEREAS, at least two-thirds (2/3) of the Alderman of the City Council for the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, believe that the public interest will be served by repealing Title III, Chapter 32, Section 126 (Ordinance No. 1995-16) and the Position of Street Superintendent (§ 32.126) of the Code of Ordinances because it has previously established by Ordinance (No. 2007-21) the position of Director of Public Works.

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, believes it will be beneficial and in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the City of Troy, Illinois, to repeal Title III, Chapter 32, Section 126 (Ordinance No. 1995-16) and the Position of Street Superintendent (§ 32.126), and amend its Code of Ordinances accordingly.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- Section 2. Title III, Chapter 32, Section 126 (Ordinance No. 1995-16) and the Position of Street Superintendent (§ 32.126) of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Troy is Illinois is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- Section 3: If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.
- Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, signing and publication as required by law.


