**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, CHAPTER 31, SECTION 32 –
COMPENSATION (MAYOR AND ALDERMEN) - OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Code of Ordinances of the City of Troy, Illinois sets forth the compensation of elected officials; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, has determined it is in the best interests of the City to adjust the compensation of elected officials, including but not limited to the Mayor and Aldermen, to adequately compensate the elected officials for the time and efforts of those elected individuals, and to attract and encourage dedicated individuals to seek public service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, has reviewed the compensation of elected officials, including but not limited to the Mayors and Aldermen of surrounding communities and the review revealed that it is necessary to adjust the compensation to make the City of Troy competitive with the compensation offered other elected officials in surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, wishes to adjust the compensation of elected officials in accordance with 65 ILCS 5/3.1-50-10 and 15; and

WHEREAS, Title III, Chapter 31, Section 32, sets forth the compensation for the City Clerk, and is hereby amended in its entirety; and

WHEREAS, the compensation of the Mayor and Aldermen as changed pursuant to this Ordinance shall become effective at such time as mandated by the laws of the State of Illinois, 65 ILCS 5/3.1-50-10 and 15, and shall become effective for terms of elected officials beginning on May 1, 2013.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

Section 2. Section 31.32 – COMPENSATION (Mayor and Aldermen) - of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Troy, Illinois, is hereby amended in its entirety as set forth herein:

TITLE III. Administration

Chapter 31 – MEMBERSHIP; ACTIONS; COMMITTEES

Section 31.32 – COMPENSATION

- (A) The Mayor shall receive as his or her compensation for the performance of his or her duties the amount of \$15,185.66 annually for the twelve (12) month period beginning May 1, 2013 through April 30, 2014. Thereafter, the compensation paid to the Mayor for the performance of his or her duties shall remain the same, without any annual increments, for the periods of May 1, 2014 through April 30, 2015; May 1, 2015 through April 30, 2016; and May 1, 2016 through April 30, 2017. The Mayor's salary shall be paid to the Mayor in twelve (12) equal monthly installments.
- (B) The Mayor shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred by him or her in attending committee meetings of the City Council and for other expenses incurred by him or her when in the course of his or her duties as Mayor.
- (C) An Alderman shall receive as compensation for the performance of his or her duties the amount of \$7,592.83 annually for the twelve (12) month period beginning May 1, 2013 through April 30, 2014. Thereafter, the compensation paid to an Alderman for the performance of his or her duties shall remain the same, without any annual increments, for the periods of May 1, 2014 through April 30, 2015; May 1, 2015 through April 30, 2016; and May 1, 2016 through April 30, 2017. An Alderman's salary shall be paid to the Alderman in twelve (12) equal monthly installments.
- (D) An Alderman shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred by him or her in attending committee meetings of the City Council and for other expenses incurred by him or her when in the course of his or her duties as Alderman.

Section 3: If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this

end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 4: All Ordinances, Resolutions, Motions and Orders that conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, signing and publication as required by law.




