**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, CHAPTER 31, SECTION 13 –
STANDING COMMITTEES ENUMERATED; DUTIES - OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, has reviewed the provisions of the current text of Title III, Chapter 31, Section 13 of the Code of Ordinances and determined that it requires certain additions and amendments to conform with current operational practices; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance will serve to establish the new standing committees for the City of Troy, Illinois, set forth in Title III, Chapter 31, Section 13 of the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, each new standing committee will then meet to discuss preparing a detailed description of the duties and responsibilities of the committee, which will subsequently be included in Title III, Chapter 31, Section 13 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Troy, Illinois, and approved at a later date; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it will be beneficial and in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the City of Troy, Illinois, to amend the Code of Ordinances accordingly.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

Section 2. Section 31.13 – Standing Committees Enumerated; Duties - of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Troy, Illinois, is hereby amended in its entirety as set forth herein:

TITLE III. Administration

Chapter 31 – MEMBERSHIP; ACTIONS; COMMITTEES

Section 31.13 – Standing Committees Enumerated; Actions

The following shall constitute the standing committees of the City Council. The following statements of duties shall be construed as generally descriptive and are not intended to limit or extend areas of responsibility for any committee.

- (A) Administrative Services:

- (C) Building & Zoning:
- (D) Community Improvement:
- (E) Economic Development:
- (F) Law Enforcement & Emergency Services:
- (G) Public Works:
- (H) Technology & Transparency:

Section 3: If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, signing and publication as required by law.
