# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, CHAPTER 31, SECTION 33 – ORDER OF BUSINESS - OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, has reviewed the provisions of the current text of Title III, Chapter 31, Section 33 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Troy, Illinois, and determined that it requires certain additions and amendments to conform with current operational practices; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, believes it will be beneficial and in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the City of Troy, Illinois, to amend the Code of Ordinances accordingly.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- Section 2. Title III, Chapter 31, Section 33 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Troy, Illinois is hereby amended in its entirety and set forth fully herein:

TITLE III. Administration

**Chapter 31 – City Council - Meetings** 

Section 33 - Order of Business

#### § 31.33 ORDER OF BUSINESS

- (A) An agenda, following the order of business outlined below, for each regular meeting of the City Council shall be prepared by 4:30 p.m. Friday immediately prior to the regular meeting:
  - (1) Review Session, covering at least one study topic, to be convened at 7:00 p.m. prior to the start of the Regular City Council meeting;
  - (2) Regular City Council meeting, to be convened at 7:30 p.m. or immediately following the Review Session if the Session adjourns after 7:30 p.m.;

- a. Pledge of allegiance;
- b. Roll call in alphabetical order;
- c. Reading and approval of minutes;
- d. Communications, to be provided by the City Clerk;
- e. Citizen participation, limited to three (3) minutes per city resident;
- f. Mayor's comments;
- g. City Administrator & City Attorney comments;
- h. Consent Agenda, including administrative reports and other items to be voted collectively with one roll call vote;
- i. Administrative Services Committee report;
- j. Budget & Finance Committee report, including a report from the City Treasurer, as well as bills to paid (on a monthly basis);
- k. Building and Zoning Committee report, including a report from the Building & Zoning Administrator;
- 1. Community Improvement Committee report;
- m. Economic Development Committee report;
- n. Law Enforcement & Emergency Services Committee report, including a report from the Chief of Police;
- o. Public Works Committee report, including a report from the Director of Public Works:
- p. Technology & Transparency Committee report;
- q. Reports of Special Committees (as needed);
- r. Ordinances & Resolutions, called by the City Clerk, with citizen participation limited to three (3) minutes per city resident;
- s. Closed Session, if needed;
- t. Adjournment, no later than 10:00 p.m.
- (B) In preparing the agenda for a regular meeting, the items to be considered under each portion of the order of business shall be listed. Any item which is not specifically listed on the agenda shall not be considered at the regular meeting unless a majority of the quorum agrees to consider the item at that meeting. This vote to consider a topic does not change the vote required by any other section of this code or by any section of the Illinois Municipal Code for the passage of any other motion, resolution or ordinance.
- (C) The City Council may, upon a majority of the quorum concurring, agree to alter the order of business for that meeting.
- Section 3. If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.
- Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, signing and publication as required by law.
