**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING TITLE IX, CHAPTER 92, SECTION 3 –
'CLEARING SNOW AND ICE FROM SIDEWALKS' – FROM THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, at least two-thirds (2/3) of the Alderman of the City Council for the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, believe that the public interest will be served by repealing Title IX, Chapter 92, Section 3 – Clearing Snow and Ice From Sidewalks – from the Code of Ordinances.

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, believes that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the City of Troy, Illinois, to repeal Title IX, Chapter 92, Section 3 – Clearing Snow and Ice From Sidewalks – from the Code of Ordinances, and amend its Code of Ordinances accordingly.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- Section 2. Title IX, Chapter 92, Section 3 – Clearing Snow and Ice From Sidewalks – from the Code of Ordinances for the City of Troy, Illinois, is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- Section 3: If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.
- Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, signing and publication as required by law.


