AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, AMENDING TITLE IX: GENERAL REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 91: NUISANCES, SANITATION AND ENVIRONMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECT SALE OF BAKED GOODS, UNDER 410 ILCS 625/3.4 (a)(c) – HOME KITCHEN OPERATION - OF THE FOOD HANDLING REGULATION ENFORCEMENT ACT, AS DESCRIBED BY 410 ILCS 625/4 – COTTAGE FOOD OPERATION

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 410 ILCS 625/3.4(a)(c), effective the date of June 10, 2014, the City of Troy, Illinois, may authorize by Ordinance the direct sale of baked goods as described in Section 4 of the Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act, 410 ILCS 625/4; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, believe that it is in the best interest of the City to authorize by Ordinance the direct sale of baked goods as described in Section 4 of the Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act, 410 ILCS 625/4, to further ensure the continued health, safety, welfare and economic prosperity of the City and its citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

Section 2. The City of Troy, Illinois, pursuant to 410 ILCS 625/3.4(a)(c), hereby authorizes the direct sale of baked goods as described in Section 4 of the Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act, 410 ILCS 625/4 et seq.

Section 3. That Title IX General Regulations, Chapter 91 Nuisances, Sanitation and Environment, of the Troy Municipal Code be amended to add the following:

“Section 91.80 Food Sanitation

The direct sale of baked goods as described in Section 4 of the Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act, 410 ILCS 625/4, and regulated through the use of a Home Kitchen Operation, as described by Section 3.4 of the Food Handling Regulation

Enforcement Act, 410 ILCS 625/3.4, of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, is authorized.”

Section 3. If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same is hereby repealed.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
