ORDINANCE NO. 2014 -20

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, AMENDING TITLE V:
PUBLIC WORKS, CHAPTER 51: UTILITIES GENERALLY; AND
AUTHORIZING THE CONVERSION OF SURPLUS RECYCLABLE METALS
INTO FUNDS DEPOSITED INTO CITY TREASURY, UNDER 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4
– SALE OR LEASE OF REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the corporate authorities of the City of Troy, Illinois, may authorize a municipal officer to convert municipal personal property, such as surplus recyclable and “scrap” metals nor longer necessary to the administration of services to the City of Troy into “some other form that is useful to the city [...] by using the material in the personal property”; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, believe that it is in the best interest of the City to convert surplus recyclable metals into funds available for further administration of City services;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1.** The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- Section 2.** The City of Troy, Illinois, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, hereby authorizes the conversion and sale of recyclable metals by the Department of Public Works into funds for use by the City of Troy, under the direction of the Director of Public Works.
- Section 3.** That Title V Public Works, Chapter 51 Utilities Generally, Administration and Enforcement, of the Troy Municipal Code be amended to add the following:

“Section 51.19 Conversion of Recyclable Metals

The Public Works Department is authorized to convert recyclable metals into funds for use by the City of Troy, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, under the direction of the Director of Public Works.”

Section 3. Pursuant to ILCS 815 325/4.1, a copy of this ordinance shall be furnished as written documentation to a Recyclable Metal Dealer as proof of the City's authorization to sell the material.

Section 4. If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 5. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.


