# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, CHAPTER 31, SECTIONS 12 & 13 - MEMBERSHIP IN COMMITTEES & STANDING COMMITTEES OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, has reviewed the provisions of the current text of Title III, Chapter 31, Sections 12 & 13 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Troy, Illinois, and determined that it requires certain additions and amendments to conform with current operational practices; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, believes it will be beneficial and in the best interest of the health, safety and general welfare of the City of Troy, Illinois, to amend the Code of Ordinances accordingly.

# NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- Section 2. Title III, Chapter 31, Section 12 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Troy, Illinois is hereby amended in its entirety and set forth fully herein:

TITLE III. Administration

Chapter 31 - City Council - Membership; Actions; Committees

Section 12 - Membership in Committees

## § 31.12 MEMBERSHIP IN COMMITTEES

- (A) The Mayor shall appoint the members of all standing and special committees, in the absence of specific direction by the City Council, and shall designate the chairperson and vice chairperson of each committee.
- (B) Every committee of the City Council shall consist of four members, including a chairman and vice chairman, unless the City Council shall provide otherwise.
- Section 3. Title III, Chapter 31, Section 13 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Troy, Illinois is hereby amended in its entirety and set forth fully herein:

**Chapter 31 – City Council - Meetings** 

Section 13 - Standing Committees

### § 31.13 STANDING COMMITTEES

The following shall constitute the standing committees of the City Council. The following statements of duties shall be construed as generally descriptive and are not intended to limit or extend areas of responsibility for any committee:

- A. Administrative & Community Services: The administrative and community services committee provides a liaison between the council and many of the city's boards and commissions, including the Planning Commission, Zoning Board of Appeals and Historic Preservation Commission. The committee also has certain oversight responsibilities specifically related to the building and zoning department. Other duties of this committee include oversight of matters pertaining to the administrative office, personnel, employment contracts, collective bargaining, and municipal property and building maintenance.
- B. Finance & Economic Development: The finance and economic development committee generally oversees all matters of purchasing, spending, bonding, taxing and other financial issues including the budget process. Major expenditures are often screened in advance by the finance committee even if the expenses have already been approved through the budget. Additionally, the Committee will provide counsel and oversight to the Economic Development and Tourism Coordinator, and provide liaison to the Economic Development Commission.
- C. Law Enforcement & Emergency Services: The law enforcement and emergency services committee oversees matters related to the police department and emergency medical and disaster preparedness powers of the municipality. This committee is charged with suggesting effective and efficient improvements in the operations of the respective operations including, but not limited to personnel levels. Although they have no influential authority in board decisions, the committee serves as a liaison to the city's board of police commissioners and police pension board. Those independent boards are charged by Illinois law with hiring, disciplining and promoting law enforcement officers and ensuring a solvent pension program for retired officers.
- D. Public Works: The public works committee is generally charged with overseeing the operations of the city's water, wastewater and street maintenance functions, including streets, sidewalks, right-of-way maintenance, storm water drainage, traffic and street signs, fleet maintenance, water and sewer infrastructure, street cleaning, and snow and ice removal.

- Section 4. If any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.
- Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, signing and publication as required by law.
