

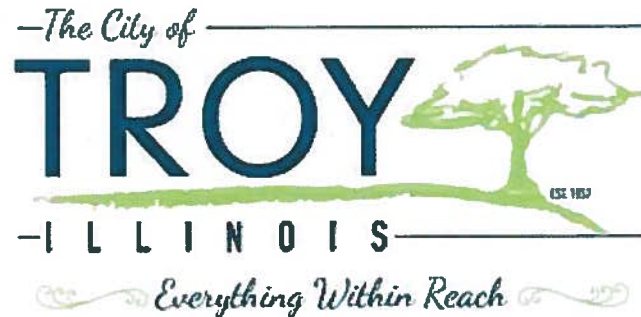

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS
AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO APPLY FOR GRANTS**

WHEREAS, the City of Troy, Illinois is applying to Madison County for Fiscal Year 2016 Sustainability Grant Program funding; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that an application be made and agreements entered into with Madison County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that an application be made and agreements entered into with Madison County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troy endeavors to provide alternative forms of transportation and recreation opportunities for its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Troy Planning Task Force identified the objective to “make Troy a pedestrian friendly community” in the 2009 Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troy identified the Spring Valley Road Multi-Use Path on its Growth Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troy desires to provide pedestrian connections between the Tri-Township Park District property, the Madison County Transit Park-n-Ride, and the Madison County Transit Bike Trail System; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troy support the Metro-East Park and Recreation District’s and Madison County Transit’s long-range plan to provide a multi-use path along US Highway 40 and a connection to the Tri-Township Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Troy shall apply for FY 16 Madison County Sustainability Grant Program funding under the terms and conditions of Madison County and shall enter into and agree to the understandings and assurances in said applications.

Section 2. The proposed project description shall be identified as Spring Valley Road Multi-Use Path Property Acquisition.

Section 3. The Mayor and City Administrator, on behalf of the City of Troy, Illinois, execute such documents and all other documents necessary for the carrying out of said application.

Section 4. The City of Troy will contribute a 20 percent minimum local match to supplement a Madison County Sustainability Grant Program award of up to \$15,000.


Section 5. The Mayor and City Administrator are authorized to provide such additional information as may be required to accomplish the obtaining of such grant.

Section 6. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval as provided by law.
