



RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION TO THE METRO-EAST PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 COMMUNITY PLANNING GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Troy, Illinois, has identified an opportunity to secure funding to enhance community planning for City residents' access to pedestrian and bicycle access through the creation, development and improvement of a City bicycle-pedestrian Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, in the City's FY 2019-2020 Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, budgeted and appropriated \$135,000 of Tax Increment Financing funds for "surveying and civil engineering of trail system"; and

WHEREAS, the Metro-East Park and Recreation District offer up to \$40,000 in matching funds, and up to 40 percent of the overall cost, through the FY 20 Community Planning Grant program; and; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, intends to complete a Bicycle and Pedestrian Infrastructure Plan, and through TIF funds, future MEPRD and IDNR grant applications, and other sources as needed, intends to construction a Bicycle and Pedestrian pathway from Clay Street to the Tri-Township Park District, and then terminating at the Madison County Transit Trail system at the intersection of Spring Valley Road and US Route 40.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- 2. The City of Troy, Illinois, shall apply for a FY20 Community Planning Grant with the Metro-East Park and Recreation District for \$40,000 in funding.
- 3. That the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Troy, Illinois, execute such documents and all other documents necessary for the carrying out of said grant applications.
- 4. That the Mayor is authorized to provide such additional information as may be required to accomplish the obtaining of such grant.
- 5. This Resolution shall be in effect following its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
- 6. Any and all Resolutions, sections or subsections of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
