RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION TO THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES BIKE PATH GRANT PROGRAM FOR MATCHING FUNDS FOR THE SPRING VALLEY ROAD BIKE PATH FROM US HWY 40 TO THE TRI-TOWNSHIP PARK DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City of Troy, Illinois, has identified an opportunity to secure matching funds from the Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) Bicycle Path Grant Program for the enhance of a bicycle trail path on the east side of Spring Valley Road from the Madison County Transit (MCT) Bicycle Path at the US Highway 40 intersection to the Tri-Township Park District property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, has previously appropriated TIF funds for the engineering of said bicycle path, which is proposed for continuance through the Tri-Township Park District and then to downtown Troy through a Master Plan being developed in partnership with the Metro-East Park & Recreation District (MEPRD); and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Natural Resources is offering a program that, upon successful application, will provide up to 50 percent in matching funds (\$200,000 maximum) of the overall costs of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, intends to complete a Bicycle and Pedestrian Infrastructure Plan, and through TIF funds, potential future MEPRD and IDNR grant applications, and other sources as needed, intends to construct a Bicycle and Pedestrian pathway from Clay Street to the Tri-Township Park District, and then terminating at the Madison County Transit Trail system at the intersection of Spring Valley Road and US Route 40.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- 2. The City of Troy, Illinois, shall apply for a Bicycle Path Grant with the Illinois Department of Natural Resources for up to \$200,000 in matching funds, dependent on engineer's estimate of final project cost.
- 3. That the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Troy, Illinois, execute such documents and all other documents necessary for the carrying out of said grant applications.
- 4. That the Mayor is authorized to provide such additional information as may be required to accomplish the obtaining of such grant.
- 5. This Resolution shall be in effect following its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
- 6. Any and all Resolutions, sections or subsections of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
