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RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, COMMITTING LOCAL FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE REBUILD ILLINOIS COMPETITIVE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION FOR THE RENOVATION OF THE PASTUERIZATION PROCESS AT THE CITY WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS THIS FIFTEENTH DAY OF JUNE, 2020

Published in pamphlet form by the authority of the City Council of the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, this Fifteenth day of June, 2020.

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WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois has taken action to submit a Rebuild Illinois competitive economic development application; and

WHEREAS, receipt of Rebuild Illinois grant assistance is essential to allow the City of Troy to undertake the project to replace the pasteurization process located at the treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, the Rebuild Illinois grant criteria are such that financial participation by the grantee is required in conjunction with Rebuild Illinois funds; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, held a public hearing on June 11, 2020, for purposes of soliciting the public's input on the commitment of funds towards this Rebuild Illinois grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troy has certain monies allocated for the above-referenced project with cash on hand, as needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- 2. The City of Troy, Illinois, does hereby commit funds from the Sewer Fund for use in conjunction with a Rebuild Illinois Grant, such funds to equal 51% of the estimated total project cost of \$1,154,500, or \$588,795.
- 3. That the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Troy, Illinois, execute such documents and all other documents necessary for the carrying out of said grant applications.
- 4. That the Mayor is authorized to provide such additional information as may be required to accomplish the obtaining of such grant.
- 5. This Resolution shall be in effect following its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
- 6. Any and all Resolutions, sections or subsections of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity
for a grant from the Rebuild Illinois program. This program is
funded by state funds as included in the 2019 Capital Bill. These
funds are to be used for a community development project that
will include the following activities: replacement of equipment
and upgrades to buildings at the City's wastewater treatment
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and upgrades to buildings at the City's wastewater treatment plant. The total amount of Rebuild Illinois funds to be requested is \$565,705. The City of Troy also proposes to expend \$588,795 in non-Rebuild Illinois funds on the project. These non-Rebuild Illinois funds will be derived from the following sources: Sewer Fund - \$588,795.
