RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF THE MADISON COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL ALL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Troy is subject to natural and man-made hazards including severe thunderstorms, severe winter storms, floods, tornadoes, and drought among others, that pose risks to public health and property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troy desires to prepare and mitigate for such natural and man-made hazards; and

WHEREAS, under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires that local jurisdictions have in place a FEMA-approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a condition of receipt of certain future Federal mitigation funding after November 1, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Multi-Jurisdictional All Hazards Mitigation Plan was updated in accordance with the regulations of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and the guidance provided by FEMA; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troy has participated in updating the Madison County Multi-Jurisdictional All Hazards Mitigation Plan covering member jurisdictions of Madison County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- 2. The City of Troy hereby adopts the Madison County Multi-Jurisdictional All Hazards Mitigation Plan update as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the City of Troy.
- 3. The City of Troy hereby further agrees to participate in the annual and 5-year updates to this Plan.
- 4. This Resolution shall be in effect following its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

PASSED by the City Council of the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, approved by the Mayor, and deposited in the office of the City Clerk this <u>21st</u> day of <u>December</u>, 2020.
