RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION TO THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL (SRTS) GRANT PROGRAM AND FOR THE USE OF MATCHING FUNDS FOR THE SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT ALONG ROUTE 162 FROM HICKORY STREET TO DEWEY STREET.

WHEREAS, the City of Troy, Illinois, has identified an opportunity to secure matching funds from the Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Grant Program, Cycle 21 Call for Projects for sidewalk replacement on both sides of IL Route 162 from Hickory Street to Dewey Street. Also, for providing a safer connection to Silver Creek Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Grant Program, upon successful application, will provide up to 80 percent in matching funds (\$250,000 maximum) towards the overall construction costs of the project.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
2. The total preliminary project cost is \$429,000, dependent on the engineer's estimate of final project cost.
3. The City of Troy, Illinois, shall apply for a Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Grant for 80% of the total project cost (\$250,000 maximum), which is \$250,000 in federal funds, dependent on engineer's estimate of final project cost.
4. The City of Troy, Illinois, shall match the SRTS Grant with 20% of the total project cost, which is \$179,000 in City General or Motor Fuel Tax funds, upon successful awarding from the Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Grant.
5. That the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Troy, Illinois, execute such documents and all other documents necessary for the carrying out of said grant applications.
6. That the Mayor is authorized to provide such additional information as may be required to accomplish the obtaining of such grant.
7. This Resolution shall be in effect following its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
8. Any and all Resolutions, sections or subsections of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



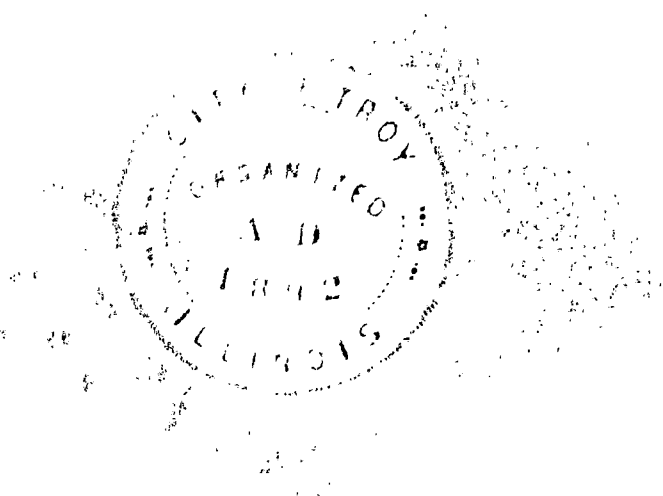


