ORDINANCE NO. 003-25

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BARNES ROOFING, INC. FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE ROOF OVER THE GYMNASIUM AT THE ELLENWOOD RECREATION CENTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that Barnes Roofing, Inc. provide the necessary replacement of the roof over the gymnasium at Ellenwood, and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a \$150,000.00 grant from the County, and the Administration recommends utilizing a portion of the grant to replace the roof over the gymnasium at Ellenwood Center, given its condition and the number of programs and activities taking place in the facility

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Barnes Roofing, Inc. for the replacement of the roof over the gymnasium at the Ellenwood Recreation Center pursuant to the terms contained in the attached quote incorporated herein.

Section 2. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the necessary sum of **Sixty-Three Thousand One Hundred Ten Dollars and Zero Cents (\$63,110.00)** from **CDBG Fund No. 200** to the Barnes Roofing, Inc. for the necessary repairs to the roof.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 038-24 is hereby repealed in its entirety due to the project's timing and that no contract was executed.

Section 4. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford, Ohio, due to the roof's age and to continue efficient services for the residents.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
