ORDINANCE NO. 006-26

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GANLEY CHRYSLER OF AURORA TO PURCHASE A 2026 DODGE DURANGO FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Bedford **desires to purchase said vehicle to continue efficient operations** for the Police Department through the State Cooperative Purchasing Contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Ganley Chrysler of Aurora to purchase said vehicles for the total amount of **Forty-Three Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars and Zero Cents (\$43,265.00)**.

Section 2. The Council of the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay Ganley Chrysler of Aurora for said vehicle.

Section 3. That the actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare, and for the further reason that it is necessary to purchase the vehicles to ensure efficient operation of the department and avoid any price increase.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
