ORDINANCE NO. 011-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 047-24 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AMEND THE CONTRACT WITH **AMERICAN ROADWAY LOGISTICS** FOR THE 2024 ROAD MARKING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council approved a contract with American Roadway Logistics for the road marking of streets in the City pursuant to Ordinance No. 047-24, and

WHEREAS, additional work was necessary and not contemplated in the original contract which increased the contract amount as stated below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to amend the contract with American Roadway Logistics for the 2024 Road Marking Program for the total amount of **Fifty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars and Zero Cents (\$53,486.00)** instead of the original amount of **Forty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Three Dollars and Zero Cents (\$49,993.00)** pursuant to the terms in the attached quote and to sign any documents necessary.

Section 2. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the sum of **Fifty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars and Zero Cents (\$53,486.00)** from **State Highway Fund No. 202** to **American Roadway Logistics** for said services pursuant to the terms of the contract.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford, Ohio, and for the further reason that the work needs to be completed prior to winter.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
