ORDINANCE NO. 013-26

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CONTRACT WITH SENIOR  
TRANSPORTATION CONNECTION FOR TRANSPORTATION SERVICES  
FOR THE RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF BEDFORD AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that Senior Transportation Connection continue transportation services to residents, and

WHEREAS, the Contractor is competent and qualified to furnish services to the City and has provided responsive and responsible services, and desires to continue to provide transportation services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Senior Transportation Connection for transportation services for the residents of the City of Bedford pursuant to the terms contained in the Transportation Services Contract.

Section 2. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the necessary sum to Senior Transportation Connection for said services.

Section 3. That the actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford, Ohio, and to continue to provide services to the residents.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
