ORDINANCE NO. 014-26

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SIGNAL SERVICE COMPANY FOR THE UPGRADE OF SIGNAGE AND TRAFFIC SIGNAL IN THE DOWNTOWN DISTRICT IN THE CITY OF BEDFORD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that Signal Service Company upgrade the signage and traffic signal at the crosswalk in the Downtown District upon the recommendation of the NOACA Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative, and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that Signal Service Company perform said upgrades, and

WHEREAS, it is the City's intention to utilize the services of Signal Service Company to upgrade the signage and traffic signal at the crosswalk in the Downtown District, funded by the NOPEC Energy Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Council for the City of Bedford authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Signal Service Company for the upgrade of signage and traffic signal in the Downtown District in the amount not to exceed **Twenty-Five Thousand Four Hundred Fifteen Dollars and Zero Cents (\$25,415.00)**.

Section 2. The Council of the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the sum to Signal Service Company pursuant to the terms of the contract from funds received from the NOPEC Energy Grant.

Section 3. That the actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare to increase awareness and safety.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
