ORDINANCE NO. 040-26

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH CARGILL FOR
SODIUM CHLORIDE (ROCK SALT) FOR THE 2026-2027 WINTER AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Bedford participated in a consortium with several communities to obtain the lowest and best bid.

WHEREAS, the administration recommends Cargill as the lowest and best bid submitted to the consortium.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Cargill pursuant to the terms of the attached contract.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate and pay the sums specified in said contract pursuant to its terms as she deems appropriate.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and to timely comply with the terms of the bid.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
