ORDINANCE NO. 045-25

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH STRYKER MEDICAL DEVICES FOR THE PURCHASE OF LIFEPAK CR2 AED DEVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief recommends the purchase of the Lifepak CR2 AED devices to replace outdated and, in some cases, inoperable devices, ensuring public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with **Stryker Medical Devices** in the amount not to exceed **Forty-Six Thousand Eighty-Two Dollars and Five Cents (\$46,082.05)** for the reasons stated above as a sole source provider.

Section 2. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay **Stryker Medical Devices** for said Lifepak CR2 AED devices.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare, and for the further reason that the City of Bedford wants to immediately purchase said equipment to enhance services and assist firefighters.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
