ORDINANCE NO. 048-25

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO
A CONTRACT WITH THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY PLANNING
COMMISSION FOR PROFESSIONAL PLANNING SERVICES AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The City was awarded a grant by the Cuyahoga County Planning Commission to prepare the 2025 Bedford Master Plan, which the City recommends accepting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Council for the City of Bedford authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with the Cuyahoga County Planning Commission for Professional Planning Services at a cost not to exceed Fifteen Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$15,000.00), which sum represents the City's match.

Section 2. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay **Cuyahoga County Planning Commission** for said Professional Planning Services pursuant to the terms of the Service Agreement.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford, for the further reason that the City can start and complete the Master Plan in a timely manner.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
