ORDINANCE NO. 048-26

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GPD GROUP FOR FEES FOR ADDITIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION PHASE OF THE WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT (WWTP) HEADWORKS UPGRADE PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City is required to complete said project to comply with EPA mandates and ensure the public peace, health, safety, and welfare, and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends GPD Group provide the Professional Design Services stated in the June 10, 2026 proposal due to their knowledge and involvement with the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. Council for the City of Bedford authorizes the City Manager to contract with GPD Group for the additional services stated in said proposal which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The Finance Director of the City of Bedford is hereby authorized to make payment pursuant to the terms of said proposal from the Wastewater Fund.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford and for the further the City desires to immediately authorize said design to expedite the project.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
