ORDINANCE NO. 052-25

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE VALLEJO COMPANY FOR THE 2025 ROAD PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that The Vallejo Company resurface portions of Palmetto Ave. and West Glendale Ave., as well as street striping and preventative maintenance items, and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that The Vallejo Company perform said services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Council for the City of Bedford authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with The Vallejo Company for the **2025 Road Program** in the amount not to exceed **Five Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Sixteen Dollars and Fifty-Seven Cents (\$564,716.57)** pursuant to the terms of the attached estimate.

Section 2. The Council of the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the sum to **The Vallejo Company** pursuant to the terms of the contract.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare to commence work.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
