ORDINANCE NO. 053-24

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH **KTS EQUIPMENT, INC.** FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE BRUSH BANDIT MODEL 15XP FOR THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Service Director recommended the purchase of the Brush Bandit Model 15XP to replace a 2007 chipper for the Service Department; and

WHEREAS, KTS Equipment, Inc. provided the lowest price for said purchase

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with KTS Equipment, Inc. for the purchase of the Brush Bandit Model 15XP for the total amount of **Sixty-Six Thousand Sixteen Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$66,016.50)**.

Section 2. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the sum of **Sixty-Six Thousand Sixteen Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$66,016.50)** from **Street M & R Fund No. 209** to **KTS Equipment, Inc.** for said purchase.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford for the efficient operation of the department, and to avoid any price increase.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
