ORDINANCE NO. 053-25

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PHILLIPS PAVING LLC FOR REPAVING THE PARKING LOT AT THE ELLENWOOD RECREATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that Phillips Paving LLC repave the parking lot at the Ellenwood Recreation Center, and

WHEREAS, Phillip Paving LLC was the lowest bidder for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with GameTime for the replacement of park equipment in the amount of **One Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Two Dollars and Zero Cents (\$133,642.00)**.

Section 2. The Council of the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay **Phillips Paving LLC** for said project pursuant to the terms of the contract.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford, Ohio, and for the further reason that the City wants to replace this equipment at a reduced rate as soon as possible.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
