ORDINANCE NO. 057-24

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH **MR. EXCAVATOR, INC.** FOR THE GREENCROFT ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, said project includes the Site clearing, including tree removals, removal of the existing corrugated metal culvert and replacement with a 7-foot by 6-foot precast concrete box culvert, replacement of the waterline below the culvert, full-width pavement replacement above the culvert, reconnection of existing drainage structures that will outlet through the new culvert outlet wingwalls, sanitary sewer replacement (including concrete encasement) below the culvert, rock channel protection at the inlet and outlet, and site restoration including the installation of new galvanized chain link fence at the inlet and outlet headwalls. Construction of the culvert will be completed under total roadway closure with a detour routing traffic utilizing Broadway Avenue, Waterbury Avenue, and Thames Avenue, and

WHEREAS, the administration recommends that Mr. Excavator, Inc. is the lowest and best bid for the project which will be reimbursed by ODOT's State Infrastructure Bank (SIB) loan awarded to the City pursuant to Resolution Nos. 2615-24 and 2619-24.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with **Mr. Excavator, Inc.** for the Greencroft Culvert Replacement Project in the amount of **Three Hundred Sixty-One Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Six Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$361,636.60)** according to the terms contained in the attached document.

Section 2. The Council of the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay the sum of **Three Hundred Sixty-One Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Six Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$361,636.60)** from **Capital Improvements Fund No. 403** to **Mr. Excavator** for said project.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford and for repairs to be done in a timely manner.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
