ORDINANCE NO. 063-26

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MONTROSE FLEET SERVICE TO PURCHASE ONE (1) 2027 DODGE DURANGO GT AWD FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Bedford wishes to purchase a new administrative vehicle in the Fire Department to continue efficient operations of the department, and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to purchase one (1) 2027 Dodge Durango GT AWD at the pricing listed on the attached quote, which is below the state bid quote.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Montrose Fleet Service for the purchase one (1) 2027 Dodge Durango GT AWD for Fire Department for the total amount of **Thirty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Twelve Dollars and Twenty-Eight Cents (\$39,412.28)**.

Section 2. The Council of the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay Montrose Fleet Service.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to purchase a vehicle in the Fire Department to ensure efficient operations of the department.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
