ORDINANCE NO. 066-25

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH **R&T FENCE INC.** TO INSTALL A PERIMETER FENCE IN THE REAR PARKING LOT OF THE BEDFORD POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends R&T Fence Inc. install the perimeter fence in the rear parking lot of the Police Department to protect city vehicles and those involved in criminal investigations; and

WHEREAS, R&T Fence Inc. was the lowest and best bidder for said project, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. Council for the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with **R&T Fence Inc.** to install a perimeter fence in the rear parking lot of the Bedford Police Department for the total amount of **Twenty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars and Twenty-One Cents (\$26,455.21)** for said installation and equipment of said project.

Section 2. The Council of the City of Bedford hereby authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate and pay F&T Fence Inc. for the installation, as outlined in terms of the quote

Section 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare, and for the further reason that it is necessary to protect the vehicles to ensure efficient operation of the department.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
