ORDINANCE NO. 068-25

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF ENGINEERING FEES TO GPD GROUP FOR THE PROFESSIONAL DESIGN SERVICES, CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION AND INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE 2025 ROAD PROGRAM IN THE CITY OF BEDFORD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the scope of this project is as follows for the Mill and Fill Resurfacing with minor repairs on Daisy Road and West Glendale Avenue, repair concrete and overlay with asphalt to Palmetto Extension from Daisy Road to the dead end, and the Cuyahoga County Preventive Maintenance items crack seal on Rockside Road, and pavement markings on Center Roda, Columbus Street, Egbert Road, Forbes Road, Rockside Road, Solon Road, Union Street, and West Grace Street, and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends GPD Group perform said services for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Council for the City of Bedford authorizes the City Manager to contract with GPD Group for the Professional Design Services, Construction Administration, and Inspection Services for the 2025 Road Program in the City of Bedford in an amount not to exceed **Thirty-Two Thousand Five Dollars and Zero Cents (\$32,500.00)** for the Design Work of the project and **Fifty-Six Thousand Five Dollars and Zero Cents (\$56,500.00)** for the Construction and Administrative, and Inspection Services of the project pursuant to the attached proposal for said project.

Section 2. The Finance Director of the City of Bedford is hereby authorized to appropriate and pay GPD Group for said services.

Section 3. The actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford and for the furtherance of the City's desires to immediately authorize said design and administrative services to expedite the project.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
