ORDINANCE NO. 089-25

AN ORDINANCE REPLACING ORDINANCE 9676-19 AND ADOPTING THE CITY OF BEDFORD CREDIT CARD USE POLICY TO CONTINUE TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH STATE MANDATED POLICY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Finance Director has recommended that Council adopt said policy for those who use credit cards to comply with the policy for proper public purpose expenditures and recordkeeping as mandated by Section 717.31 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Council hereby approves, adopts and amends the policy attached hereto and incorporate by reference, and hereby repeals Ordinance No. 9676-19 and Codified Ordinance Section 133.24.

Section 2. That the actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 ORC.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby determined to be an emergency measure necessary to implement the policy to conform to the Ohio Law and clarify procedures as stated above.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
