Re: December 15th Council Meeting – United Survey Inc. / Sewer Lining

The administration recommends contracting with United Survey Inc. to line two separate sections of sewers. Lining both sewers will prevent future repairs that could include the replacement of the line which would be much more expensive. In 2024, the city was forced to outsource repairs on two separate locations on the sanitary legs that were too deep for service staff to repair. These repairs cost the city just under \$100,000.00 for approximately 40 feet of pipe that was repaired.

The attached quote details roughly 540 feet of sanitary pipe which will be lined at two separate locations. The first section is located at 400 Center Road. The pipe size is 10", the flow is sanitary, and the depth is roughly 11 ½ feet. United Survey will line from manhole to manhole which is approximately 170 feet.

The second location is another sanitary leg which would start at 910 McKinley and flow to Northfield Road. This leg is 10" and the depth is roughly 10 ½ feet. The line was televised in June 2025 by Service Department employees then chain cut to remove restrictions. During inspection and cleaning, staff identified areas where the pipe is cracked, and joints are open. This section of pipe that will be lined extends 370 feet.

To avoid future, more costly repairs, the administration recommends contracting with United Survey Inc. to line these sewers. The total cost is \$37,800.00.
