RESOLUTION NO. 2624-25

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR A GRANT THROUGH THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION TO COMPLETE VARIOUS PLANNING, ZONING, AND RELATED TECHNICAL PROJECTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Administration recommends that the City apply for a grant through the Community Planning Services Program (CPSP) for various projects including updating the Master Plan and Planning Codes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bedford, County of Cuyahoga, and the State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for a grant through the CPSP to complete various planning, zoning, and related technical projects and sign any documents necessary to apply and accept any grant.

Section 2. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City of Bedford for the further reason that the City wants to immediately apply for said grant in a timely manner.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
