

**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-14**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE  
VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON  
MACOUPIN AND JERSEY COUNTIES, ILLINOIS**

**CHAPTER 30  
SECTION 05  
DUTIES**

**WHEREAS**, on July 1, 2024, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton adopted the above Ordinance regarding the duties of its Governing Body; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton have reviewed the Ordinance describing the duties of the Mayor, and have determined that the Mayor fulfills his hourly obligation as required by the Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, said Ordinance indicates the Mayor shall fulfill his hourly obligations in the designated office of the Mayor, which is located at the Village Municipal building; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees recognizes the Mayor also serves the Village of Brighton in his official capacity as Mayor outside of the designated office of the Mayor; and


**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees acknowledges requiring the Mayor to fulfill all his hourly obligations only in his office would be a hardship on the Mayor, and a detriment to the citizens at-large.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON, MACOUPIN AND JERSEY COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:**

- Section 1. That Chapter 30, Section 05, Paragraph (A)(3) shall be stricken in its entirety.
- Section 2. All other terms and conditions of said Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval by the President of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton.
