

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-05

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PROPERTY
OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON
MACOUPIN AND JERSEY COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton are the owners of: five (5) Axon X26P TASER Devices; nine (9) TASER cartridges, expired in 2024; and three (3) Blackhawk TASER holsters; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton has determined that such property is no longer necessary or useful to the Village; and

WHEREAS, authority is given to the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton to authorize the sale of such surplus property, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton declare it in the best interest of the Village to dispose of said property; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton declares said property as surplus property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON, MACOUPIN AND JERSEY COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. Authorization to Dispose of Surplus Property. Sargeant Dustin Ford, of the Brighton Police Department, will be in charge of said sale.


Section 2. Terms of the Sale of Surplus Property. Sargeant Dustin Ford will sell said surplus property "as-is" only to another law enforcement department or authorized agency due to the inherent danger of the said surplus property. The terms of the sale shall be in accordance with the laws of the United States of America and the laws of the State of Illinois.

Section 3. Proceeds. The proceeds from said sale shall be deposited in the 'Police Department' line item of the General Fund.


Section 4. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton.
