**An Ordinance of the City of Corry, Erie, County Pennsylvania
Establishing a Statutory Maximum Speed Limit of 25 Miles Per
Hour For Motor Vehicles Traveling on Certain Roadways
within the City.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to 75 Pa. C.S.A. §§ 3362(a)(1.2) and 3363 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, municipalities, subject to 75 Pa. C.S.A. § 6109(e), are authorized to set the speed limit at twenty-five (25) miles per hour on certain roads within the City without a prior engineering and traffic study;

WHEREAS, East Washington Street, East Smith Street, Maple Avenue, Pepper Lane, Random Road, Russel Road, and Wayne Street are located in a residence district as defined under 75 Pa. C.S.A. § 102 of the Vehicle Code and are residential streets;

WHEREAS, under 75 Pa. C.S.A. § 3362(a)(1.2) the maximum speed of a street in a residence district is twenty-five (25) miles per hour if the road is not a numbered traffic route and is functionally classified by PennDOT as a local highway;

WHEREAS, under 75 Pa. C.S.A. § 3363, a local municipality may amend the maximum speed limit in a residence district if supported by an engineering and traffic study;

WHEREAS, pursuant to 75 Pa. C.S.A. § 6109(e), an engineering and traffic study is not necessary to establish a speed limit under section 3362(a)(1.2) (relating to maximum speed limits in residence districts);

WHEREAS, under 67 Pa. Code §212.108, an engineering and traffic study is not necessary to impose the statutory speed limit of twenty-five (25) miles per hour;

WHEREAS, East Washington Street, East Smith Street, Maple Avenue, Pepper Lane, Random Road, Russel Road, and Wayne Street are not numbered traffic routes and are functionally classified as local highways by PennDOT; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary for the safety of public travel on East Washington Street, East Smith Street, Maple Avenue, Pepper Lane, Random Road, Russel Road, and Wayne Street that the speed limit on those roads be reduced to twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Corry City Council, Erie County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION 1. The caption of and recitals to this Ordinance as set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. Speed Limit Established. The following maximums speed limits are hereby established:

Road	Location	Maximum Speed Limit
East Washington Street	entire length	25
East Smith Street	entire length	25
Maple Avenue	entire length	25
Pepper Lane	entire length	25
Random Road	entire length	25
Russel Road	West Columbus Ave. to Random Rd.	25
Wayne Street	entire length	25

SECTION 3. Enforcement. This Ordinance shall be enforce by the Corry Police Department or any other authorized police officer in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania as it pertains to fines and other penalties.

SECTION 4. Posting of Signs. After the effective date of the Ordinance, the City shall ensure that the existing speed limit signs along the Roads identified in Section 2 are replaced with the appropriate new speed limit signs, which shall be erected in accordance with the regulations adopted by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.


SECTION 5. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance or its application to any person(s) or circumstances is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court, such holding(s) shall not be construed to affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of the Ordinance. It is hereby declared the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such invalid or unconstitutional provision or its application not be included herein.

SECTION 6. Repealer. Any other Ordinance or parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be and are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately after adoption of the Ordinance by the City Council .
