**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CORRY, ERIE COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1570 / COUNCIL  
BILL NO. 17-01, ENTITLED "CORRY FIRE & EMERGENCY SERVICES  
BILLING ORDINANCE."**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Corry, Erie County, Pennsylvania, enacted Ordinance No. 1570 / Council Bill No. 17-01 on June 19, 2017, authorizing the City of Corry Fire Bureau to recover all costs and expenses for its fire and emergency services from property owners and occupants through claims submitted to the property owners' and/or occupants' insurance policies; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Corry has reviewed the continued necessity and effectiveness of said ordinance and determined that its provisions are no longer in the best interest of the City and its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to repeal Ordinance No. 1570 / Council Bill No. 17-01 in its entirety.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the City Council of the City of Corry, Erie County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

**SECTION 1 – Repeal of Ordinance.** Ordinance No. 1570 / Council Bill No. 17-01, adopted on June 19, 2017, entitled "Corry Fire & Emergency Services Billing Ordinance," is hereby **repealed in its entirety** and shall be of no further force or effect.

**SECTION 2 – Severability.** If any provision of this Ordinance is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining provisions, which shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3 – Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment according to law.
