AN ORDINANCE Amending Ordinance No. 1672, fixing the salaries and wages of City Officials, Officers, and Employees of the City of Corry for the year 2026.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Section 10903(a) of the Third Class City Code, 11 Pa. C.S. § 10903(a), the salary of an elected officer cannot be increased or diminished after the officer's election; and

WHEREAS, at time the current Treasurer was elected, the Treasurer salary, as set by Ord. No.1658 adopted December 16th, 2024, was \$50,000;

WHEREAS, the salary listed for the Police Lieutenant in Ordinance No. 1672 contained a typographical error that does not reflect the salary intended and approved by City Council; and

WHEREAS, City Council has reviewed and recommended an adjustment to the salary of the Public Works Manager; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to amend Ordinance No. 1672 to correct the identified error and to implement the recommended salary adjustments in a clear and consolidated manner;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Corry, and it is hereby enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. Amendment to Section 2 – City Treasurer

Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1672 is hereby amended to read as follows:

City of Corry Treasurer: \$50,000.00

All other language in Section 2 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

Section 2. Amendment to Section 3 – Police Lieutenant

Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1672 is hereby amended to revise the salary for the Police Lieutenant as follows: **Police Lieutenant: \$81,025.00**

All other language contained in Section 3 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

Section 3. Amendment to Section 3 – Public Works Manager

Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1672 is hereby further amended to revise the salary for the Public Works Manager as follows: **Public Works Manager: \$85,000.00**

All other language contained in Section 3 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

Section 4. Repealer


All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 5. Retroactive Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and shall be retroactive to January 1, 2026, for purposes of salary administration and compensation.
