A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FORGIVENESS OF ANY UNPAID INVOICES ISSUED BY THE CITY PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 1570 / COUNCIL BILL NO. 17-01, THE "CORRY FIRE & EMERGENCY SERVICES BILLING ORDINANCE."

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 1667 / Council Bill No. 25-06, City Council repealed Ordinance No. 1570 / Council Bill No. 17-01, the Corry Fire & Emergency Services Billing Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 1570, individuals were billed for Fire & Emergency Services provided by the City; and

WHEREAS, since Ordinance No. 1570's adoption, the City has accrued a balance of \$26,937.50 in unpaid invoices for billings related to Fire & Emergency Services; and

WHEREAS, in light of the adoption of Ordinance No. 1667 / Council Bill No. 25-06, City Council wishes to forgive the current outstanding balances billed by the City to various individuals pursuant to Ordinance No. 1570.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Corry as follows: hereby authorizes the City Administrator, or other designated City officials to write off all remaining unpaid invoices issued pursuant to Ordinance No. 1570 and to reflect such adjustments in the City's financial records accordingly.


Section 1. The caption of and recitals to this Ordinance as set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.


Section 2. City Council hereby forgives the current balance of unpaid invoices issued pursuant to Ordinance No. 1570 / Council Bill No. 17-01, the Corry Fire & Emergency Services Billing Ordinance, which is approximately \$26,937.50.

Section 3. The City Administrator, or their designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to effectuate the forgiveness of all outstanding invoices issued pursuant to Ordinance No. 1570 and to reflect such adjustments in the City's financial records accordingly.
