**A Resolution of the City of Corry, Erie County Pennsylvania Establishing
Guidelines for the Corry Police Department for Police Officers Making
Warrantless Arrests Pursuant to 42 Pa. C.S.A. § 8902.**

WHEREAS, 42 Pa. C.S.A. § 8902 provides that a police officer shall have the right of arrest without a warrant upon probable cause for certain specific summary offenses;

WHEREAS, 42 Pa. C.S.A. § 8902(b) provides that City Council shall promulgate guidelines to be followed by City police officers when making a warrantless arrest for a summary offense pursuant to Section 8902;

WHEREAS, City Council, at the recommendation of the City Chief of Police, desires to adopt guidelines for City police officers when making a warrantless arrest under 42 Pa. C.S.A. § 8902.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by City Council of the City of Corry, Erie County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. The foregoing background recitals are incorporated into and made a substantive portion of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. Guidelines for Arrests pursuant to 42 Pa. C.S.A. § 8902. Any arrest by a City police officer pursuant to 42 Pa. C.S.A. § 8902 shall proceed in accordance with the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, Title 234 of the Pa. Code, Sections 440, Arrest Without Warrant, and 441, Procedure Following Arrest Without Warrant.

SECTION 3. Modification. City Council reserves the right to modify, supplement, or amend the Resolution from time to time by resolution or ordinance.


SECTION 4. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution or its application to any person(s) or circumstances is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court, such holding(s) shall not be construed to affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of the Resolution. It is hereby declared the legislative intent that this Resolution would have been adopted had such invalid or unconstitutional provision or its application not be included herein.

SECTION 5. Repealor. This Resolution shall supersede prior resolutions on the matter set forth herein.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately.


